### Radio Frequencies used at the the CCRC Club Field.

All 2.4 Ghz Spread Spectrum radios can be flown safely.

On the 72 Mhz band, channels 14 and 22 can not be used. Channels 30 through 35 are somewhat dirty and are not recommended. All 72 Mhz band radios will be impounded and are required to use frequency pins.
